Formalities & Guidelines

Submissions will be judged by the board of the Industrial PhD & Postdoc Association and professional communicators from Videnskab.dk and University of Copenhagen. The prizes are DKK 16,000; 8,000 and 4,000 for first, second and third place, respectively. The prizes are awarded at the annual meeting of The Danish Academy of Technical Sciences (ATV) 26 April 2016. The articles of the winners get the chance to be published on Videnskab.dk and ScienceNordic.com

All participants will be invited for a feedback meeting hosted by the Industrial PhD & Postdoc Association.

Eligibility: The competition is open to members of the Industrial PhD & Postdoc Association who are currently employed as Industrial PhDs or Postdocs, as well as former Industrial PhD students that have defended their PhD thesis after 1 March 2015. Your submission must include:

1. A popular science article of max 7000 characters, incl. spacebar (excl. illustrations). This document must be anonymized (i.e. your name must not appear in this file). The submissions cannot have been published previously. The language has to be either Danish or English and the format must be MS Word. You are welcome to include illustrations in this file.
2. A separate file containing 1) the title of the popular science article, 2) your name, email address and phone number, 3) the company and university that you are affiliated with, 4) your title (Industrial PhD or Postdoc student), and 5) the expected end date of your Industrial PhD or Postdoc position.

Submissions that do not meet these guidelines will be disqualified.
